Wedding Ceremony



Surround yourself with a 360-degree view at the top of the mountain, a perfect backdrop for exquisite wedding photos. Exchange your vows in a place so majestic you'll want to share it forever.

In case of rain or inclement weather, a "backup plan" is available.



Romantic Chairlift Ride – Summit Express

Happily, Ever After... starts here. Brides and grooms and their guests can ride the Summit Express lift before and after the wedding ceremony. Or, why not have your bridal procession begin at the bottom of the mountain? The wedding party can ride the lift to the top of the mountain allowing time to absorb the spectacular views.



Pricing:

Summer Season (Friday-Sunday)

July 10 to September 7, 2026: \$20 per person (available 10 am – 6 pm). NOTE: The public has access to lift rides.

Off-Summer Season

After hours rates apply on Monday-Thursday (excluding holidays) from July 10-September 30th. : \$20 per person + surcharge cost: \$400 for the first two hours, \$300 for every additional hour.

Blackout Dates:

The venue is not available during Sugar Mountain's annual Food Truck Festival (May 23rd) or on the Fourth of July. The last date available for weddings in 2026 is September 30th.

- Upper main room (150 guests max.) \$ 800
- New section (180 guests max.) \$ 800
- Last Run Lounge (80 guests max.) \$ 1000
- Front deck & grounds (180 guests) \$ 1000
- Entire lodge (incl. front deck & grounds, 770 guests) \$ 4000
- Maple Leaf Room (20 guests max.) \$ 200
- Mountain top ceremony \$ 500
- Refundable damage / cleaning deposit \$ 1000

All food and beverage services shall be organized through Sugar Mountain Food Service. Our catering service will provide you with a variety of food choices to create your unique reception menu.



Service of Alcoholic Beverages

Sugar Mountain Food Service has beverage facilities and staff, as well as their own beverage inventory and liquor license. For your wedding reception, you have the option of including a cash bar or a hosted bar. Hosted beverage packages are available through Sugar Mountain Food Service only, and costs can vary depending upon the length of time and products included. Our beverage policy follows standards set by the North Carolina ABC Commission.
